



## **Village Improvement Association-Lowe II Scholarship**

The Village Improvement Association (VIA) is awarding a \$5,000 scholarship toward a Master Degree with monies provided by the Lowe II Foundation, a private, non-profit, family owned and governed foundation.

All applications must be completed and received by Monday, February 3, 2020. The top three (3) candidates will be selected in a blind scoring by three (3) outside education professionals. The final blind selection will be made by the VIA Education Scholarship Committee.

A check for \$5,000 will be mailed to the winner's University of their choice. This institution must be a non-profit. The recipients will be honored at the VIA Clubhouse on Monday, May 18, 2020.

### **Criteria for the Village Improvement Association-Lowe II Education Scholarship**

All applicants must:

- Be employed by the Cape Henlopen School System or the Sussex Technical High School System
- Be currently enrolled in a Master's Degree program at an accredited, non-profit University or College with six (6) hours earned by Monday, February 3, 2020
- Be enrolled in an "Education related" field  
(Administrative and Counseling programs are excluded)
- Submit an official copy of both undergraduate and graduate transcripts

- Submit student information: School name, address, telephone number, and student ID number
